

## Communication of significant environmental aspects TOLSA 2023

In order to comply with ISO 14001:2015 and ISO 22470 and 22480 on Sustainable Mining, TOLSA S.A communicates to its relevant stakeholders the main findings and environmental aspects\*/\*\* identified and assessed as significant in the organization.

### **Main conclusions:**

1. Increased electricity consumption at our Vicálvaro mine, due to the increase in milling activity in 2023 vs. 2022. However, our photovoltaic installations contribute to minimize this impact thanks to our self-generation capacity.

2. Increased natural gas consumption and associated Co2 emissions at the mill, largely due to climatic factors that have increased the humidity of the ore and forced the company to make greater use of artificial drying. This trend is being reversed thanks to the implementation of energy efficiency measures.

3. Reduction of waste from expired flavorings at the Madrid plant through compliance with the waste minimization plan.

4. Reduced consumption of rigid HDPE plastics in the factory, due to the use of sustainable packaging.
